December 2007 (photo at left), before any construction or demolition. The old fellowship hall, kitchen, and adjacent rooms are at the bottom of the photo (section with the darker shingles on the roof). The Administrative wing, Education wing, and Sanctuary are all visible in this shot.

April 25, 2008 (photo at right), just after demolition was completed and fresh sand had been brought in and graded. Trenches for the foundation are also visible. The old fellowship hall, kitchen, and restrooms are gone. A small section of dark shingles remain - this is the former thrift shop and library area, which will be renovated.





June 12, 2008 (photo at left). Slabs for the floors of all rooms have been poured, and concrete block walls are being erected. Walls for the new thrift shop are complete, included the gable end. The other walls are nearing 10 feet in height, which will be their finish height except for the fellowship hall, which will be 16 feet high.
